In Spain health information professionals share common interests and activities. However, due to their geographical dispersion and diverse typology, they face difficulties in maintaining cohesion and building relationships.

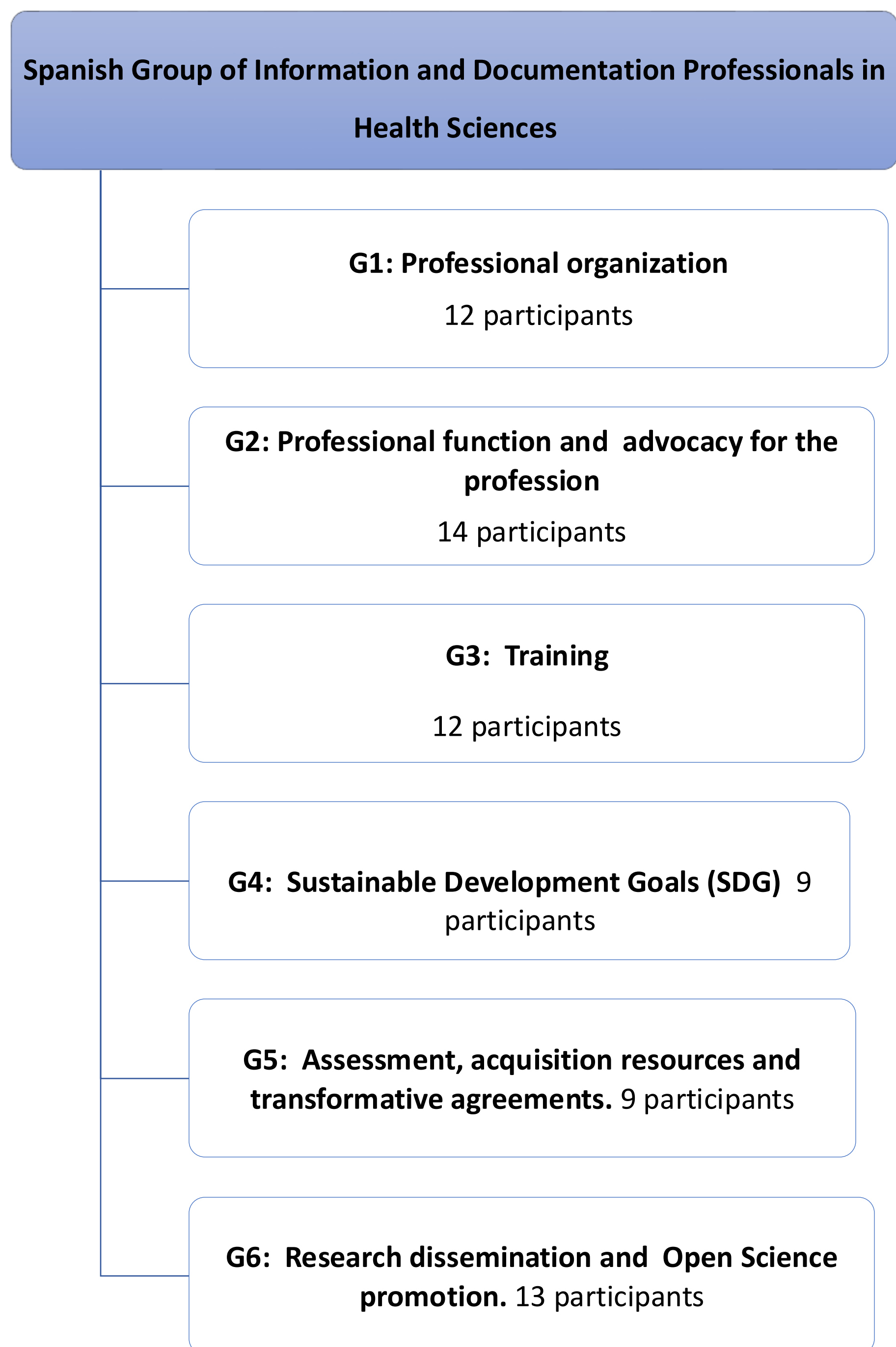
